Bilingual/ESL/LEP Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten:

Program Focus: Students will receive language-rich, TEKS-focused instruction in this 120 hour State-mandated program.

Dates: June 1st – June 22nd (Monday – Thursday)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Location: Van Junior High School

Eligibility: Pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten students receiving Bilingual, ESL, LEP services.

Fee: None

Elementary Credit Recovery, Attendance Make-up, and TEKS Mastery for Third Graders Scoring Below a Level II on Phase-in 1 STAAR Spring 2017

Program Focus: Students will receive TEKS focused instruction in math and reading.

Dates: June 1st– June 15th (Monday-Thursday)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Location: Van Junior High School

Eligibility: Kindergarten – Third Grade students who did not pass for the year or who require attendance make-up. Any student who scored below a Level II on the STAAR Spring 2016.

Fee: None

2017-2018 Elementary/Intermediate Going into Grades K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd (Reading [Early Literacy] Acceleration)

Program Focus: Students will receive TEKS focused instruction in math and reading.

Dates: June 1st – June 22nd (Monday-Thursday)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Location: Van Junior High School

Eligibility: Students who will be going into K, 1st, 2nd, or 3rd grade needing more intensive reading/early literacy instruction. Eligible students will be notified.

Fee: None

Middle School and Junior High Summer School SSI Accelerated Instruction for STAAR

Grades 5 & 8 Math and Reading Retests on June 20 (Math) and June 21 (Reading), 2017

(Mandatory for Students not Passing with a Level II at Phase-in 1 or Above in Order to Be Considered for Grade Promotion)

Program Focus: Students will receive TEKS focused instruction reading.

Dates: June 1st – June 19th Plus STAAR Re-Tests: June 20th (Math Retest) and June 21st for (Reading Retest) (Monday-Thursday)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Location: Van Junior High School

Eligibility: 5th & 8th grade students who did not pass for the year or who did not pass with a Level II or higher in Reading or Math or who require attendance make-up or who are invited to attend in math.

Fee: None

***Students will retake Grades 5 & 8 (3rd Retest) Math, June 20th (Tuesday), Tuesday at 8:00 a.m.**

***Students will retake Grades 5 & 8 (3rd Retest) Reading, June 21st (Wednesday), Wednesday at 8:00 a.m.**

Middle School and Junior High Summer School

Grades 4, 6, 7, & 8 Students Who Did Not Make a Level II at Phase-in 1 or Higher on STAAR Test in Reading/Writing; Math is by Invitation Only.

4th Grade – Reading/Writing/Math

6th Grade – Reading/Math

7th Grade – Reading/Writing/Math

8th Grade – Science/Social Studies/Math

(TEKS Instruction Offered for Students not Passing with a Level II or Above on STAAR State Assessment)

Program Focus: Students will receive TEKS focused instruction in reading.

Dates: June 1st– June 15th (Monday-Thursday)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Location: Van Junior High School

Eligibility: 4th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students who did not pass for the year, or who did not pass with a Level II or higher in Reading, Math (by invitation), Writing, Science, or Social Studies, or who require attendance make-up.

Fee: None

Secondary STAAR End of Course (EOC) Summer School Information

End of Course Exam Preparation & Credit Recovery for EOC Courses

Instructional Focus: Students will receive TEKS focused instruction in preparation for the 2nd administration of the EOC exam scheduled for June 19th – June 23rd.

Dates: June 1st – June 19th (All students and teachers will meet June 1st at 8:00 a.m. to register for courses. Classes will then be assigned in 1-1/2 hour increments to be announced immediately following registration.)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (Monday- Thursday)

Location: Van Junior High School

Eligibility: Any high school student who did not meet Level II on a STAAR EOC State Assessment or who failed an EOC course, or who wishes to retake an EOC exam to increase his/her cumulative score on any EOC exam

Fee: None

EOC Exams: June 19th: English I

June 20th: U.S. History

June 21st: English II

June 22nd: Biology

June 23rd: Algebra I

Dates: June 1st – June 22nd for **APEX** courses (Monday-Thursday)

June 1st – June 22nd for **English IV** courses (Monday-Friday)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.; **Monday – Thursday for Apex courses**

8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.; **Monday-Friday for English IV Courses**

Location: Van High School

Fees: \$175.00 for **English IV**

\$100.00 for **APEX** digital courses for Credit Recovery

Eligibility:

- Credit recovery for all core subjects
- Graduation requirement

High School Summer Program Focus:

Credit Acceleration for Summer 2017:

- *Credit by Exam: June 19th – June 23rd

***NOTE: Registration for Credit by Exam must be completed at least one or more months prior to the exam. Students will want to prepare and study for a Credit by Exam at least one month before taking. If you are interested, please contact a campus counselor.**

Credit by exam fees:

- All grades (K-12) credit by exam
 - \$19 fee per exam (most exams are only for one semester). Fees are non-refundable.
 - Individual CBEs expire in 60 days

- **Direct Teacher Instruction: English IV ONLY:** For students who **have not** previously taken this course before. (**Class meets Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m.– 4:00 p.m. beginning June 1st - June 22nd at Van High School**)

Credit Recovery:

- **Digital:** English I, English II, English III, English IV, World Geography, World History, U.S. History, Government, and Economics offered through APEX.
 - **Direct Teacher Instruction:** Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History.
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Exit Level TAKS Exams: Monday, June 19th (ELA), Tuesday, June 20th (Math), June 21st (Science), & June 22nd (Social Studies)

High School Summer School Registration Information

- **Sign-up May 1st – 19th with the high school counselor. Sign-up sheet is in the high school counselors' office.**
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Accelerated Instruction for Grades 1-12:

- June 19th – June 23rd, 2017

NOTE: Registration for Credit by Exam must be completed at least one month prior to the exam by contact the school counselor. Students will want to prepare and study for a Credit by Exam at least one month before taking the test. If you are interested, please contact a campus counselor.

Credit by exam fees:

- All grades (K-12) credit by exam
 - \$19.00 fee per exam. (Most exams are for one semester of credit). The fee is non-refundable.
 - Individual CBEs expire in 60 day.
